The purpose of summer reading is to keep your brain engaged, all summer long. This year we will be reading

World Literature. You are expected to read **three books**: *A Long Walk to Water* by Linda Sue **Park** and **two** listed choice books. Feel free to use outside resources if you feel stuck with understanding the readings. However, make sure your writing is 100% you. The essays will demonstrate your abilities in reading and writing, so try your best.

A Long Walk to Water Essay- This book follows the stories of two separate people in Sudan, Salva Dut and Nya. You may use themes from either story, or both stories. Write a five paragraph essay that follows how a theme develops over the course of the text. Use specific examples with page numbers and use the OREO handout. Track a few themes as you read with examples and page numbers.

Themes: Never give up, hope and resilience, how far one must go to survive.

Character Analysis- One character analysis from each choice text. Four paragraphs total. A two paragraph character analysis of the protagonist and how he/she changes and develops over the course of the novel. Use specific examples with page numbers. Track the protagonist's character traits as you read by writing down specific examples with page numbers.

Paragraph 1: Name, appearances, strengths, weaknesses, motives, actions in beginning of text

Paragraph 2: Actions in end of text, how that changes
